

# Squeers Lake Controlled Winter Fishery

**Saturday March 10 to Sunday March 18, 2012**

The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources is looking for anglers to participate in the 2012 Squeers Lake controlled winter fishery. This is the 28<sup>th</sup> year of a study to determine the maximum harvest that lakes similar to Squeers Lake can sustain without affecting the lake trout population's ability to replace itself.

Anglers interested in participating in the study can apply to fish up to three days (**one weekend day** and **two weekdays**) by completing an application form and sending it to:
